



UNIFORM POLICY

RATIONALE

The aim of the Park House English School (PHES) uniform policy is to ensure that students attend school in the correct uniform at all times.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The implementation of the policy will be fair, firm and consistent for all students. Students, teachers and parents will be made aware of the correct uniform so that they understand what is allowed and what is not allowed when attending Park House English School.

PROCEDURES

Uniform – All Key Stages

Students are required to wear the correct uniform at all times when at Park House English School.

Shoes

School shoes should be black leather (or leather look) and polished. Canvas shoes, sports branded shoes, trainers or trainer-style shoes should not be worn. **This includes black leather trainers.** Parents should select your child's school shoes carefully to avoid having to purchase a second pair.

Jewelry should not be worn at any time by students. This includes necklaces, rings, bracelets, anklets, sunglasses, nose piercings or anything else deemed as jewelry. A single set of small ear studs are permitted.

A wristwatch may be worn by students, however, the school will not be held responsible for any damage or loss to the item. (not Apple watches)

Make-up

Students should not wear any form of nail varnish when in school. Discreet use of make-up may be worn by students, however, excessive use of make-up will not be tolerated.

Hair Styles / Headwear

Students at Park House English School must not have extreme hair styles. This includes the use of bright colours, wearing of combs, caps, hats, headbands, bandanas and any other headwear.

Hoodies / Sweatshirts

Hoodies (Including PHES School Trip type hoodies) or non-PHES jumpers, sweatshirts or jackets should not be worn and will be confiscated, even in colder weather. Please be aware that Park House English School will not be held responsible for any item of clothes that is confiscated as a result of not following the school rules.

A PHES fleece and school jumpers are available to buy from the school's uniform supplier.

Gender Specific**Boys:**

- Must have their shirts tucked in at all times when on school premises.
- Fashion belts with large buckles should not be at any time

Girls:

- Must have non-fitted shirts when on school premises.
- Skirts must be below the knee and adhere to the expectations of the country that we live in. Leggings or tights must be worn under any shirts from Year 3 or above.

- Leggings Black only





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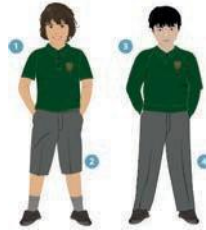

- Dark Green Polo Shirt
- Boys Shorts
- Boys Trousers
- Jumper
- Polar Fleece (Optional)
- Black/Grey Socks



PE kit

- Park House kit shorts
- Park House kit t-shirt
- Park House kit socks or white sports socks
- Training shoes with non-marking soles
- Leggings and Tracksuit bottoms (black)
- Girls must wear leggings under the shorts from Year 3

Swimming Kit

- Swimming shorts or trunks for boys
- One-piece swimming costume for girls
- Goggles
- Flip-flops
- Towel

No jewelry is allowed to be worn in school other than a watch (not Apple watches) and small stud earrings.

Girls - Primary and Secondary

- Girls Short Sleeve Blouse (Year 2 and below)
- Girls Skirt below the knee
- Girls Trousers
- Cardigan (Optional)
- Polar Fleece (Optional)
- Black socks
- Black headscarf (if worn)

(Girls can wear trousers or skirts)





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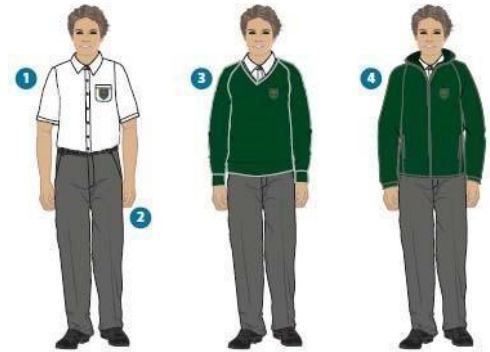
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Boys- Primary and Secondary

- Boys Short Sleeve Shirt
- Boys Trousers
- Boys Shorts (Primary only)
- Jumper (Optional)
- Polar Fleece (Optional)
- Black Socks

(Boys wear trousers from Year 7 upwards)



6th Form Uniform Boys

- Black tailored trousers
- White Park House shirt. If wearing a vest or t-shirt underneath, it must be plain white
- Park House black fleece jacket/Black v-neck pullover
- Black socks
- School tie

6th Form Uniform Girls

- Black tailored trousers or skirt: below the knee and not tight fitting
- Park House blouse with plain white t-shirt or vest worn underneath
- Park House black v-neck pullover
- Black socks/ tights
- Black headscarf (if worn)

All students must wear the correct uniform at all times. Students that fail to follow the school rules will be subject to consequences and sanctions as outlined in the schools Behaviour Policy.
