Educational Philosophy

At Park House, we are passionate about learning and are driven by our quest to ensure that students take responsibility for their own futures by becoming successful, creative and happy lifelong learners.

In the Early Years, we follow the topics of the carefully structured and varied International Primary Curriculum programme based on the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. We nurture a child-centred approach to learning, where children are encouraged to develop their social, emotional, physical and intellectual skills; skills that they will rely on for the rest of their lives.

In our Primary School, English and Mathematics are taught with the guidance of the National Curriculum of England. To ensure breadth we incorporate the International Primary Curriculum; a thematic, cross-curricular, enquiry-based approach to learning with the eight personal goals underpinning all that we aim to achieve in school.

In our Secondary School, we also follow the National Curriculum of England in Key Stage 3, thus preparing our students well for the choices they will make at (I)GCSE and A-Level. Our approach helps our students achieve exceptional academic results that are amongst the best in the world. Extra-curricular activities extend the opportunities for students even further. We believe that nurturing reflective learners and actively encouraging leadership ensures that students can develop, progress, and have the resilience to compete at the highest levels in all areas of life.

Excellent Facilities

We are privileged to have a range of excellent facilities and our well-resourced classrooms and learning areas provide optimum conditions for learning.

Our facilities include:

- Our Heather Brennan Auditorium which is used for a range of events, from assemblies to music and theatre performances, with a capacity for more than 300 people. This includes a state-of-the-art sound and lighting system.
- Excellent sports facilities include a large multi-purpose sports hall, a 25-metre swimming pool, a multi-purpose astroturf sports pitch, and shaded outdoor play areas.
- A dedicated Sixth Form Centre, which provides a wonderful environment for our Year 12 and 13 students to collaborate, socialise and relax.
- Well-equipped music and arts facilities, including dedicated music, art and performance facilities.
- Two completely refurbished libraries offer a bright, welcoming space for our students. They house thousands of books, computer workstations, comfortable seating and study areas.
- Four ICT laboratories with multimedia facilities, 3D printing equipment and iPads for classroom use. Every classroom has an interactive touchscreen smartboard.
- Six fully-equipped science laboratories.
- A cafeteria, in partnership with Kid's Kanteen, a healthy food service provider operated by 'IFS Qatar', to supply snacks and packed lunches.

There is a rigorous selection process, and academic excellence in all classes is a requirement. The students are then given multiple opportunities in the form of interschool conferences to debate important, relevant topics in the world today.

Duke of Edinburgh International Award (Secondary Students Only)

We are one of the few secondary schools in Doha to offer the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award, a youth awards programme founded in the UK that recognises adolescents and young adults for completing a series of self-improvement exercises. It equips young people for life regardless of their background, culture, physical ability, skills and interests, pushes young people to their personal limits, and recognises their achievements.
